Dr. Linda Partridge studies the biology of ageing, in particular the mechanisms that contribute to a long and healthy lifespan as well as how the rate of ageing evolves in nature. Her research is currently directed toward developing treatments that improve health during the human ageing process. Dr. Partridge is the Director of the University College London Institute of Healthy Ageing as well as the founding director of the Max Planck Institute for Biology of Ageing in Cologne, Germany. She is a recipient of the prestigious Darwin-Wallace Medal of the Linnean Society of London, historically awarded only once every 50 years for “major advances in evolutionary biology.”
